YEAR 9

Pupils in Year 9 complete a skills-based training course in new media technologies, which introduces them to concepts including:

- Robotics
- 3-D printing

Pupils also explore a variety of more advanced techniques within the spheres of art, photography and textiles, all of which will link to the overarching theme of *Food*.
